

PhD Fellowship in Chemistry

A PhD Fellowship in Chemistry is available in the Polymerization Processes Group at the Basque Center for Macromolecular Design and Engineering, POLYMAT Fundazioa (www.polymat.eu) studying the synthesis of structured nanoparticles for coating applications in collaboration with Syngenta (Jealott's Hill, UK) .

Applicants must have a BSc and MSc in Chemistry (or a related discipline). A background in polymer science is highly desirable.

Good command of written and spoken English is a must (if preselected, a telephone interview will be carried out before any other appointment is made). The selected candidate is expected to conduct research, write papers, and deliver a PhD thesis.

- (i) a cover letter highlighting their interest in the position.
- (ii) curriculum vitae.
- (iii) a short description of previous research (1-2 Pages).
- (iv) the names and contact addresses (e-mail) of two academic referees.
