

PhD Fellowship in Polymerization in Dispersed media

Two PhD Fellowships in Chemistry are available in the Polymerization Processes Group at the Basque Center for Macromolecular Design and Engineering, POLYMAT Fundazioa (www.polymat.eu) as part of the Industrial Liaison Program (www.ehu.eus/es/web/polymat/industrial-liaison-program).

Applicants must have an MSc in Chemistry (or a related discipline). A background in polymer science is highly desirable.

Good command of written and spoken English is a must (if preselected, a telephone interview will be carried out before any other appointment is made). The selected candidate is expected to conduct research, write papers, and deliver a PhD thesis.

Applications should be addressed to Dr. Nicholas Ballard and sent via email in **one single PDF** to nicholas.ballard@polymat.eu before the 1st October 2022 (applications will be considered upon arrival) including:

- (i) a cover letter highlighting their interest in the position.
- (ii) curriculum vitae.
- (iii) a short description of previous research (1-2 Pages).
- (iv) the names and contact addresses (e-mail) of two academic referees.
